

Clinical Shadowing Program: This program provides the NIH T32 Cancer Cell Biology Training Grant students with an opportunity to experience a close-up glimpse at cancer from the clinical point of view. The students have the opportunity to observe, first-hand, the operative management of oncology patients in their research field of interest. Students will be matched with appropriate faculty and be allowed to shadow that faculty member through a clinical case that best matches their interests.

This will allow the students to not only gain a better understanding of the anatomical basis for their tumor study of choice, but also the impact that their research may have on patients.
